

Exercise 2: (3.75 points)


- a) Find the equation of the straight line that goes through the point A(-2,7) if the value of its slope is $5 \rightarrow y = 5x + 17$
- b) Find the general equation of the straight line that goes through the points P(3,-5) and $Q(-1,6) \rightarrow 11x+4y-13=0$
- c) Find the equation of the straight line that goes through the points P(7,2) and Q(7,-1) x=7
- d) Given the straight line x 4y + 5 = 0 find the values of the slope and the y-intercept (0.75)

$$\begin{cases} m = 1/4 \\ n = 5/4 \end{cases}$$

e) Find the general equation of the straight line that's parallel to 4x - 5y - 2 = 0 and goes through the point $P(-3,4) \rightarrow 4x - 5y + 32 = 0$ (0.75)



a)
$$f(x) = x^2 - 2x + 1$$





b)
$$f(x) = 9 - x^2$$



Exercise 4: (2.75 points) Sketch the graph of the following piecewise function:

$$f(x) = \begin{cases} 5 & -7 < x \le -2 \\ 3 - x & -2 < x < 2 \\ x^2 - 8x + 12 & x \ge 2 \end{cases}$$
